Secondly, data-driven directions to support the vision will be key in achieving the RPIC vision over the coming years. RPIC is working with key partners to assess the professional development needs of the real property community. A community survey will be launched in 2024. The data and feedback will help us identify the learning and training needs of our community, helping curate professional development programming that is in tune with what the community deems critical to support them in their daily work. Be sure to participate and submit your thoughts.

Thirdly, on the item of providing value in relation to the first and second items. With your input, RPIC will explore where we can provide more value to you not just at events but through enhanced community engagement. As examples, we will look to address emerging issues, provide function community-based roundtables, and enshrine RPIC's Interchange into the

Government of Canada talent management offerings. We hope to ensure valuable professional development opportunities are provided to you, and the community.

Before I close, I want to leave you with a call to action to engage with RPIC and all we have planned over this year:

- Join us at an upcoming event. The <u>2024 RPIC calendar is live</u> with the complete lineup of events planned for this year.
- In tandem, join us in developing the programming for our upcoming events. Following up on our Comptroller General of Canada's message from last year- step out of your comfort zone and present at our Workshops and other learning events. Demonstrate what is top of mind for leaders to our base of real property professionals; share your success or "not such a success" stories.
- Join the <u>RPIC team</u>: engage with the Board or one of our Professional Development (PD) organizing committees.
- Get involved in nominating your teams for their excellent and innovative work through our Awards and Recognition Programs.
- The RPIC Mentorship Program is coming back in 2024! Join as a mentor or mentee. We look to our senior professionals and executives to mentor those up and coming in our community.
- Consider a stretch or transition <u>interchange opportunity at RPIC</u> for yourselves or your team. We would love to have you join us.

To summarize, in 2024, the RPIC Board of Directors and staff will focus on delivering programing that will help educate and develop our community and provide opportunities for them to grow their connections and networks.

Last but certainly not least, thank you to our partners, whose support enables RPIC to continue providing valuable professional development programs and other resources to the community. Without them, the work we do at RPIC to support the Real Property community and fulfil our mission would not be possible.
